

Visual Estimates

It can be difficult to guess what a wind power project is going to look like in your community. The following images can help you get an idea of how much of the turbine will be visible, and from where.

Since turbines are best sited on high elevations where wind speeds are faster, they can usually be seen from a great distance away. While this turbine will be visible in many areas of the surrounding community, the large separation distance ensures it does not dominate the view. Areas much closer to the project location, such as along Parker Mountain Rd, have much more restricted views of the turbine due to the lack of cleared land.

The views shown represent areas from where the turbine is most visible; the valley floor.
